Did you know Albert Einstein could not speak until he was four years old, and did not read until he was seven? His parents and teachers worried about his mental ability. Did you know that Beethoven's music teacher said about him, 'As a composer he is hopeless,' or that when Thomas Edison was a young boy, his teachers said he was so stupid he could never learn anything?
