Message from our Minister

We live in a rapidly changing world, and sometimes it just seems hard to keep up. Technology is a huge part of life now, whether we like it or not; attitudes and feelings towards a multitude of topics has changed dramatically over the past few years, and are continuing to change; and of course, the coronavirus pandemic has pushed us into previously uncharted waters, to coin a phrase. It's no wonder people are feeling the pressure and stress is a very real issue for many; and inevitably some in the Christian community are thinking that we must be living in the end times. I am reminded of a quote I came across a while ago...

"Our earth is degenerate in these latter days; bribery and corruption are common; children no longer obey their parents; and the end of the world is evidently approaching." Assyrian clay tablet 2800 BC.

The bible verse I am always drawn to when I think about things like this is Hebrews 13:8, 'Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever'.
